

West Basin is Under Threat & Needs Your Help



Points for Concern in the Acton Peninsula Precinct draft Structure Plan

1. Four storey high buildings proposed for this Liversidge Street area will sit above the tree canopy and dominate the skyline
2. Building zones here are too large and too close to the lake. All buildings in the Basin should be public and cultural.
3. The junction of pedestrian bike paths from west West Basin and east West Basin is not working. All of these routes are in lake bed infill.
4. The Building Estate in this triangle remains a travesty involving selling off our parkland and lakebed land to developers for private housing that will obliterate our parkland AND block significant vistas from City Hill, Vernon Circle and Commonwealth Avenue.
